ATTENDANCE ACCREDITATION AND ACCESS

- Access to the combat areas will be restricted to the fencers and accredited persons only⁺, i.e., referees, coaches, journalists and photographers with press credentials.
- Admission for the spectators and the accompanying persons is free of charge but limited to the availability within the spectators' stands and common areas.
- Fencers should not leave their weapon bags and equipment in the stands of the main hall and its passages; a dedicated space shall be available for athletes' belongings.

HORAIRES*

Friday 14 February: Welcome to fencers and mandatory control of their equipment

17h – 20h: Initial control:

- > Equipment: in accordance with FIE regulations
- Weapons: in accordance with EFC for U23 competitions: Masks, gloves and the blades will be controlled
- 17h 20h: Registration, payment and confirmation of fencers' participation

REGISTRATION - ENTRY FEES

Registration of fencers, coaches and referees from Europe and other continents is only possible for those with a valid EFC license. All registrations must be made via the EFC service portal no later than 7 days preceding the start of the competition.

* These times are approximate and will be confirmed on the official website of the event: (<u>Events - Antony Sports Escrime</u>) once the registration is closed or one week before the competition.

Entry fees must be paid in cash when registering on site:

- Individual Competitions: 30 €
- Team Competitions: 100 €

REFERRING AND RULES OF ENGAMENT

FORMULA:

The EFC adopts the same formula as those of the FIE Junior World Cups. In individual competitions, pools will be composed as follows:

- 1. Junior FIE ranking
- 2. EFC U23 circuit ranking + 500
- 3. Places for unranked fencers are drawn at random.

In team competitions, the composition of the table will be based on the EFC team ranking.

PARTICIPANTS IN THE INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION:

Each member federation may enrol a total of 24 fencers aged 13 to 23 for each tournament. Given the overall objective of the project, we anticipate that federations will register 12 fencers in the U-23 category and 12 fencers in the U-20 category. If a federation does not use its quota of 12 registered U-23 fencers, the remaining number, up to a maximum of 6 fencers, can be used by the federation to register additional fencers in the U-20 category.

The host country, in this case France, will have its quota doubled.

PARTICIPANTS IN THE TEAM COMPETITION:

One team per country may be enrolled with each team having at least two U-20 fencers

REFEREEING: According to EFC rules:

- 1 to 3 registered fencers: no referee
- 4 to 9 registered fencers: 1 referee
- 10-15 registered fencers: 2 referees
- 16-24 registered fencers: 3 referees
- For teams Competitions: 1 referee per team

License level: EFC C or FIE referee categories are required

In the event of non-registration of each required number of referees via the EFC service portal, the associated federation must pay a fee of 500.00 EUR to the EFC. This will be necessary to cover the expenses of the missing referees appointed by the EFC.

Note: The EFC delegate will hold a debrief meeting for all referees 45 minutes before the start of competitions. All referees must attend.

PRIZES

The top 4 finishers in individual events will all be rewarded. The first 4 teams will be rewarded.
